How to Obtain and Play Our Podcast Files

There are two ways to access podcast files: manually, by playing them at our website or by direct download; or automatically, by subscription to the podcast.

You can play the podcast by visiting our website and use the player on the right side of the page. To download a podcast episode by direct download, visit our website, go to the bottom of an episode's show notes, and right-click on the Direct Download link. In the next box displayed, click on "Save Link As...", and then decide where on your computer you want to save the podcast file. Once the file has finished downloading, go to that file on your computer and click on it, and whatever software on your PC or Macintosh is set up to play MP3-format files will begin to play the podcast.

To obtain a podcast file automatically by subscription, you will first need to download and install some free "podcatching" software. The most popular software used to do this is iTunes, available as a free download from the Apple Web site, at <http://www.apple.com/itunes>. Using iTunes, you would choose "Subscribe to Podcast..." under the Advanced menu. In order to subscribe to the Genealogy Guys Podcast, you would enter <http://genealogyguys.com/rss> into the URL box and press OK. Once you have subscribed to the Genealogy Guys Podcast, it will appear in your list of subscriptions when you click on "Podcasts" in the Library menu on the left-hand side of the iTunes page. Whenever you choose, you can click on the Refresh button at the bottom right of the iTunes page, and iTunes will automatically visit **The Genealogy Guys Podcast** website to check for new episodes. Those episodes' MP3 files will be automatically downloaded to your computer. You can then use iTunes to play them.
